Ecodairy a highly diversified and automated dairy farm beside the trans Canada highway has built a direct sales retail market around consumer education and omega 3 enriched milk. The farm has recently added an Avatar scalable plug flow digester which produces electricity, heat and bedding for the dairy. John, who is also president of Artex barn solutions, a dairy stabling and equipment manufacturer, will talk about diversification and value added approaches to dairy production and their role in our industry future."

Birchlawn Farms Ltd. operated by the Terpstra family, milk 450 cows using a 40 cow rotary parlour. In the barn, cattle activity monitors. **RFID** identification and management software are used. automatic feed pusher runs 6 times a day. Birchlawn was one of the first Ontario farms certified for the CQM program in 2009. In 2011, they completed construction of a manure digester that incorporates 4 primary tanks and one secondary digester tank to power a 440 kW generator. In addition to manure, the digester system can utilize fats, oils and greases from the restaurant and food

sector. A DariTech manure separator and press removes manure solids which are recycled as bedding.

Evergreen Holsteins, operated by Robert and Andrea Van Nes, milk 440 cows. Activity monitors are used, pregnancy rate is 22-26%. In 2010, the farm installed a BeddingMaster manure composter that turns separated manure solids into compost in 28 hours. The composter operates 24 hours a day. Liquids from the manure press are reused in the manure system. Cows are bedded every day using the compost. A new 5-row, all steel, 260' x 110' heifer barn was completed in January 2011. The barn is designed with the option to double the barn width to a 10 row, cross ventilated barn with 2 feed alleys for milking cows.

St. Brigid's Dairy Ltd operated by Bill and Cindy Van Nes is an organic dairy farm currently milking 260 cows. A new loose housing barn was built in 2010. Cows are milked in a swing 20 parlour. In the summer, cows are outside 19 hours a day. Ration is grass forage based. The pasture wire for grazing is moved 5 to 6 times a day. Emphasis is on milk solids per acre. Herd averages 4.6% butterfat and 3.8% protein. Milk is shipped to Harmony Organic. Afi activity monitors on cows. Movable super hutches with mob feeders are used for calves.

Conlee Farms operated by Ralph and Paulette Coneybeare, built a new slatted floor free stall barn in 2011, following a barn fire in 2010. Ralph designed the barn and was general contractor. Cows are milked in 2 Lely A4 robots. Barn has a unique maternity and special needs pen area. Barn features include LED lighting used throughout the barn, tan

interior barn colour instead of white, robot slat cleaner that can use water, a custom built hydraulic cow lift for use when treating cows, Agsource mattresses, activity monitors with 11 readers throughout the barn. The farm is currently building a new calf barn. Ralph has patented the "Coneybearicade" liftable manger front for reducing feed being pushed away while allowing easy feeding and cleaning.
